## A New Vision

Camp ministry has been on my heart for a long time, dating all the way back to my first summers as a counselor at Northland Camp. When we arrived in Peru in 2006 to begin the ministry of full-time evangelism, we believed that camp ministry would become a significant part of accomplishing our goal of helping local churches in Latin America.

As we've gotten to know the churches in Peru these last few years, we believe that God is leading us to begin a new camp in Peru. A camp that has served numbers of churches throughout the Lima area will soon be shutting its doors, and we believe that God is opening the way for us now to start this new camp.

A quality camp is built around four key aspects: **philosophy, people, program** and **place**. With our background at Northland Camp, and in working with Camps Abroad, God has allowed us to develop a solid Christian camp *philosophy* based on our confidence in the power of the Word to change lives.

When it comes to *people*, Peru is an ideal place to have a Christian camp since there are hundreds of fundamental churches throughout the country with believers who will benefit both as campers and as staff members. When it comes to *program*, the Lord has given us a great background in program work with camps, and Camps Abroad has come alongside of us working specifically in that area of program.

As we look at what God has done in preparing the way for the start-up of this new camp, we realize that the next step is to purchase and develop a *place* that will allow us to serve the local churches in Peru for many years.
