We praise the Lord that our support level is continuing to rise. Two churches have taken us on this past month and another has doubled their level of support for us. Some individuals have taken on our support, and we are officially at 60%. We believe the Lord will make it possible for us to leave for Peru towards the end of this coming summer.

Starting this Sunday, February 12th, our schedule is full all the way into June. We will be in Florida, the Carolinas, and Tennessee until April. After that, we will be in and out of Michigan, Illinois, and Wisconsin through June. Pray that the Lord will give us great meetings with churches as we push towards the end of our deputation.

We have two and a half more weeks before we will start driving from Michigan to Florida. In that time, we have to move all of our things out of the house we have been living in for the last year and a half. We are packing most of our things to be ready to ship to Peru. We will store them until we ship them this summer. Pray for us as we make decisions concerning what to take and what to leave.

I talked a few days ago with my friend, Segundo Rodriguez. He is an evangelist in Peru. He took the difficult step this past summer into full-time evangelism, and God has provided for Him and is opening many doors of ministry for Him. God has given him a real vision for the ministry of the evangelist in Peru. He recognizes what I recognize- that there is a great need in the churches for fundamental evangelists who will preach the Word with passion, exhorting believers to obedience and purity and pleading with unbelievers to be saved. It's exciting to think of all that God will do in Peru in the coming years, especially as we remember that God will do "abundantly above all that we ask or think."
