

## *Prayer Letter*

Wednesday, April 26, 2006

Dear Friends,

We put 5,900 miles on our van in a seven week period from late February to the middle of April. On that trip we visited 14 churches- 11 of them for first-time deputation meetings. The Lord has given us the opportunity to share our burden for ministry with some great people in great churches, and we praise Him for that.

We have definite plans for leaving for Peru in August or September of this year. We believe God is opening the way for us to be able to reach that goal, and we are very excited about it. When we first get to Peru we will be living in the home of Jim and Becky Carlton in Lima. They will be leaving for furlough in July of this year and we will have the use of their home through at least April of 2007. Their home is very close to one of the churches that we have strongly considered as a home church for us in Peru. We believe that is probably God's leading in this situation.

We are officially at 82% of our support. We do need to reach 100% of our support before leaving for Peru. God has been providing our support rapidly in the last several months. Praise the Lord!

This Saturday April 29th my friend and fellow evangelist, Segundo Rodriguez, will be coming to the U.S. for a period of about a month. Most of his trip he will spend with us and will be traveling with us. It will be good for folks in churches to meet him and to be able to hear first-hand what God is doing in Peru. One of the desires I have long-term is that God will raise up Latin American evangelists to minister in their own countries. We have plans in the near future to establish an association of evangelists with the purposes of organizing the promulgation of evangelists in Latin America and providing some funding for them to do this work. We want to begin the process of developing this association and promoting it while Segundo is here traveling with us.

Continue to pray that God will provide the remainder of our support. Pray also that God will lay out our path clearly before us as we make preparations for full-time ministry in Peru.
