In the last month and a half I've been preaching mainly in Lima. I had multi-night campaigns with three different churches. For one of the churches I preached three Saturday nights to their youth. On the corresponding three Friday nights, I met with a group of 9 of their leaders and taught them and challenged them on personal/spiritual life and leadership. We also did a single-night evangelistic outreach for our own church. The church folks brought over 30 visitors, mostly adults, and the Lord gave us several professions of salvation.

This past week I spent at a seminary in the mountain town of Urubamba, an hour's drive from Cusco. The seminary has around 30 students and we had a great time together. I preached 13 times during the week. I believe the Lord used His word to work in the hearts and lives of the students.



During the week in Urubamba, I got to know several of the Peruvian teachers fairly well. Two of them are pastors in the area and I had a chance to each lunch with both of them individually and talk about ministry, pastoring in Peru, and needs in general among the churches here. It will be profitable for us as we begin to write out our vision for ministry and then set specific goals that we believe God wants us to work towards.
