Two young men from our church in Lima joined me for the trip as well as a teenager from another church in Lima. We had a very fruitful week together. We preached throughout the week in the school and in the church (I preached 12 times). On Friday we ran a day of games and preaching. They loved the camp-style games like big-ball volleyball and tube tug. At the invitation of the last
